DETAILED INFORMATION

1. General information

Leonardo UK Limited, operating under the direction and coordination of Leonardo Società per Azioni (Leonardo SpA), an Italian joint stock company, is issuing this call for tender for the provision of hard and soft facilities management services, including catering, across its UK estate.

Leonardo SpA is a global security company that realises multi-domain technological capabilities in Aerospace, Defence and Security. Leonardo UK Limited (hereinafter referred to as "Leonardo") is one of the UK's leading aerospace companies and one of biggest suppliers of defence and security equipment to the UK Ministry of Defence. The company operates from 8 main sites across the country, along with its corporate head office in London, employing around 8,500 highly skilled people. Globally, Leonardo SpA is among the top ten world players in Aerospace, Defence and Security, with more than 53,000 employees and a significant industrial presence in Italy, the United Kingdom, Poland and the USA. 2. Services

Engineering Services & Environmental Compliance (Waste) services for Leonardo are currently outsourced across one contract. The estimated total combined value of the contract is £2,600,000 per annum.

Leonardo is seeking a strategic partnership(s) with an Engineering Services & Environmental Compliance (Waste) Services provider(s) to deliver a comprehensive serivce encompassing the delivery of mechanical and electrical maintenance, statutory compliance, and both planned and reactive maintenance for production assets and plant at Yeovil — including surface treatment systems, LEV systems, water treatment assets, paint booths, and other specialist process equipment — together with the provision of total waste management, hazardous and non-hazardous waste handling, recycling and material recovery, incident management response, environmental sampling, spill response, and environmental permit compliance.

2.1 Lot Structure

The Engineering Services and Environmental Compliance (Waste) requirements will be procured under **two separate lots**, each with its own contractual Terms & Conditions:

- Lot 1 Engineering Services
- Lot 2 Environmental Compliance (Waste) Services

The following conditions apply:

- Bidders may submit a proposal for either Lot 1, Lot 2, or both.
- Each lot will be evaluated independently, in line with its specific scope, deliverables, and Terms & Conditions.
- Bidders wishing to bid for both lots must demonstrate full competency, capability, and compliance for both service areas.

Evidence must clearly show the organisation's ability to deliver both Engineering Services and Environmental Compliance services to the required standards.



Leonardo reserves the right to award **one or both lots**, and may award them to **one supplier or two separate suppliers** depending on the evaluation results and overall best value for money.

3. Entities admitted to tender

The following are admitted to participate in the tender process:

UK registered companies

The following entities are excluded from participating in the tender process:

- Suppliers heavily reliant on Leonardo Group: Suppliers whose annual turnover is more than 70% derived from orders placed by one or more companies within the Leonardo Group are not permitted to bid unless explicitly authorised by Leonardo
- Parent and subsidiary companies: Both a parent company and its subsidiaries cannot participate in the same tender. If this rule is violated, both entities will be disqualified.
- Entities lacking professional reliability: Any bidder deemed by Leonardo to lack the necessary professional reliability will be excluded from the tender without explanation. This includes, but is not limited to, bidders who, within the past three years, have:
 - o Had a contract terminated due to breach with Leonardo SpA or any Leonardo Group company.
 - Delivered works, services, or supplies deemed non-compliant with contract requirements by Leonardo SpA or any Leonardo Group company.
 - Violated provisions of the Leonardo SpA and Leonardo Group Code of Ethics in previous contracts.
 - Failed to take delivery of goods or services assigned by Leonardo SpA or any Leonardo Group company due to default or negligence.
 - o Had a previously awarded Leonardo tender revoked.

4. Minimum requirements for participation

Entities meeting the following minimum requirements for participation (hereinafter "Minimum Requirements") may be invited to tender:

1. Financial Capacity

- Lot 1 Engineering Services Annual UK turnover £3,000,000.
- Lot 2 Environmental Compliance (Waste) Services Annual UK turnover £4,800,000.
- Combined Lots Annual UK turnover of at least £7,200,000.

2. Certifications and Standards (evidence must be provided)

For both Lot 1 and Lot 2.

- Certification to ISO 14001 and/or ISO 50001 environmental/energy management systems
- Certification to ISO 9001 (or demonstrably equivalent quality management standard)
- Certification to ISO 45001 (occupational health and safety)



3. Experience and Operational Capability (evidence must be provided)

Experience and Operational Capability

Lot 1 - Minimum of 1 Engineering Services contract valued at over £1 million, managed in the last 3 years in the UK within a production and manufacturing environment, demonstrating established operational capability and supporting supply chain(s).

Lot 2 – Minimum of Environmental Compliance (Waste) Services valued over £1.5 million managed in the last 3 years in the UK within a production and manufacturing environment, demonstrating established operational capability and supporting supply chain(s).

5. Disclosure of Interest

By the deadline of this Call for Tender, parties interested in being invited to tender, provided they meet the requirements, are required to:

Personal data will be used solely for purposes related to the tender process, including assessment of eligibility, contract award, and contract management. Data may be shared with relevant third parties (e.g. auditors, advisors, service providers) as necessary and will be retained in line with Leonardo's data retention policies.

Leonardo retains full discretion to decide whether to award the tender, award only part of the contract, restart the tender process, or modify the invitation to tender.
