Gian Piero Cutillo has been Co-General Manager of Leonardo since 7 May 2026.

He graduated in Economics from the University of Siena and holds a Master's degree in Business Administration from the University of Turin.

He has decades of experience within the Leonardo Group, which he joined in 2003.

From 2017 to 2026, he served as Managing Director of the Helicopters Division, contributing to the expansion of the Division's commercial business and industrial network, ensuring solid and continuous economic and financial growth, and strengthening Leonardo's competitive positioning in the global helicopter sector.

From 2012 to 2017, he held the role of Chief Financial Officer, after taking on increasing responsibilities within the Group's Finance and Planning & Control functions.
